

The Simon Keith Foundation has two objectives. First and foremost, our goal is to support the kids. We have a tremendous amount of respect and empathy for those courageous, inspiring and resilient kids who have the courage to continue to fight through everything that having a transplant entails. It is not an easy road, but I can assure you, any recipient that is fortunate enough to receive this lifesaving gift wouldn't trade it for anything.

Through your generous support, we have helped hundreds and hundreds of kids. From paying for gym memberships, to buying drum sets; from sending kids to overnight camps, to getting kids back and active in their sport or activity of their choice, the SKF plays an integral part in each recipient's process. Our passion lies in helping these kids believe that they can be active and healthy again. The kids continue to be our driving inspiration.

Our second objective is to raise organ donor awareness. This includes increasing awareness, getting more people to talk and register as organ, eye and tissue donors and ultimately saving more lives. The advent of technology - like being able to register in the USA directly on the Apple iPhone Health App - has led to great strides and increases in both the US and Canada. In fact, did you know that the state of Nevada recovers and transplants more organs per capita than anywhere else in the USA and most likely the world? This is primarily the work of the Nevada Donor Network - the Nevada based organ procurement organization - of which I have the privilege of acting as their Chief Operating Officer. However, like any great accomplishment, it takes a multitude of people and organizations to achieve such results, and we like to think that the SKF has played a small part in that success.

Our support has come from three primary sources. The Engelstad Family Foundation has been the anchor of our organization. Their trust and vision of us has allowed the SKF to grow and flourish. They are true transformational philanthropists, and we are honored to be their partner. Our second source has been the support of my fellow Canadians. The support we receive from Canada (and primarily from my hometown of Victoria, British Columbia) is incredible. This group of generous, happy, polite, beer drinking, loyal friends from Canada have been influential in the growth of the SKF. 















Chris' first competitive soccer game after not playing for most of his life 'due to his health

McGarry, Betty Engelstad, and families have shown great trust in us and we pledge to never let them down as we support families and raise awareness for organ, eve and tissue donation.




































































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
